Almost a third of young people are not undertaking any education by age 18 – compared to just one in five in France and Germany. A low skill workforce is not good for UK nor the individual.

The UK's productivity gap with France, Germany and the US has doubled since 2008 to 18 per cent, costing us £3,400 in lost output per person.

50%

UK Labour productivity in the 12 years following the financial crisis was less than 50 per-cent that of the 25 richest OECD countries.






